Saint Patrick's Day Sunday, March 17th was made an official Christian feast day in the early 17th century and is observed by many. The day commemorates Saint Patrick and the arrival of Christianity in Ireland, and celebrates the heritage and culture of the Irish in general. Celebrations generally involve public parades, festivals, and the wearing of green attire or shamrocks.

Historically the Lenten restrictions on eating and drinking alcohol were lifted for the day, which has encouraged and propagated the holiday's tradition of alcohol consumption.

Easter Sunday April 21st is a holiday celebrating the resurrection of Jesus from the dead, described as having occurred on the third day after his crucifixion. It is the culmination of Lent, a 40 day period of fasting, prayer, and penance.

Easter is linked to the Jewish Passover by much of its symbolism, as well as by its position in the calendar. In most European languages the feast called Easter was the term used to translate Passover. Easter customs vary across the Christian world, and include sunrise services exclaiming the Paschal greeting and decorating Easter eggs (symbols of the empty tomb). The Easter lily, a symbol of the resurrection, traditionally decorates the churches on this day and for the rest of Eastertide. Additional customs that have become associated with Easter include egg hunting, the Easter Bunny, and Easter parades. There are also various traditional Easter foods that vary regionally.
